## **We Lead The Way In Generosity**

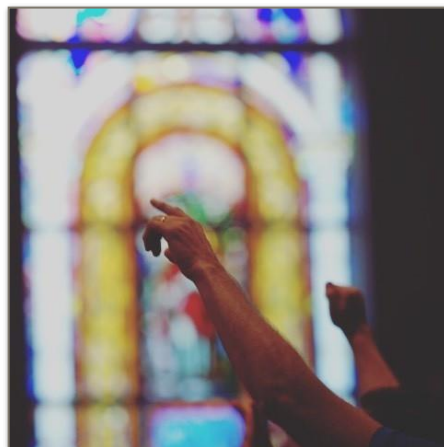
All of our resources are gifts from a loving God. Because of His great generosity, we respond with sacrificial giving. You can't outgive God.

# SYSTEMS, COMMUNICATION, & REQUIREMENTS

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE WORSHIP MINISTRY?

The Adult Worship Ministry is open for 16 years and older to participate. However, the maturity of any young person can certainly be considered. The Youth and Kids Worship Ministry is open to anyone at the discretion of the leadership. There is a place of service for many people within the team, however, there are some requirements that must be met and maintained.

## BE ON TIME

If you are not on time, it has the potential to drive the morale down for the entire team. If you are more than 15 minutes late for Sound Check or Production Service and have not called anyone, you could be asked to sit out for the day; only extenuating circumstances will be considered. There could have been last minute changes to arrangements or to the order of worship that you would be unaware of.

- Adult Rehearsals are each Thursday night at 7:00pm and include: scheduled musicians, vocalists, lead producer, sound techs, and media techs. Rehearsals typically last from 90 - 120 minutes. Childcare for ages 0 - 12 yrs provided.
- Sunday Morning Sound Check is every Sunday at 7:50am and includes Worship Leaders, Lead Producer, Band, Sound Tech, Lighting Tech, Media Tech, and Live Stream Production team.
- Production Service - Sunday mornings at 8:00am - includes the entire team mentioned above. This is the time when we run through the flow of the entire service including hosting, video(s), any creative elements, etc. so that we are well prepared for both of our Sunday morning experiences.

## COMMUNICATION

Phone Calls, Emails, Texts, & GroupMe. Information for rehearsal, Sunday morning, and/or Special Celebration information is ready to view every Monday by Noon on Planning Center Online. Planning Center Online [www.planningcenteronline.com](http://www.planningcenteronline.com) is an online tool for ministries to maintain a people and music database. When emails are sent from Planning Center regarding rehearsal or celebration info, click "accept" or "decline" to indicate whether or not you will be at rehearsal and the upcoming celebration. You can also sign up for "Text Response" under your Planning Center profile.

- Please submit responses to Planning Center requests by Monday at Noon.
- If you are running late to Sound Check, Rehearsal, or Service please have the courtesy to let your Team Leader know. If you are committed to be at a rehearsal or celebration and are suddenly unable to attend, please have the courtesy of informing your team leader (with a 24-hour notice if possible).
- Calendars, upcoming events, etc. can be found on our church website: trinityworship.net.
- We encourage you to take time off as needed. As soon as you know you will be absent, please let us know as soon as possible so we may plan accordingly by using the “block out” feature on your Planning Center calendar.

## **ATTENDANCE**

If this is the church that God has called you to, be committed to your church body. Attend at least 3 out of 4 worship services in a month’s time whether you are on schedule or not. Your commitment to our church body is crucial; your attendance proves your commitment.

## **ENGAGE WITH THE WORD**

All team members should select at least one service where you are listening to the sermon. We come under the same spiritual covering and teachings from God’s Word; no one is exempt. This is really about honoring the Word of God. Before you are a musician, you are a worshiper; and there is no such thing as true worship divorced from God’s Word. The Word gives us a God worth worshiping. A God worth leading others to worship. And the intensity of your own personal worship and your effectiveness in leading others in theirs is directly related to your engagement with it.

## **DRESS CODE**

Those ministering on stage should dress modestly for services. A casual dress is fine, but our goal is to never draw attention to ourselves and away from our purpose of worship. If t-shirts are worn, they should be neat, fitted, and clean.

## **SOCIAL MEDIA PROTOCOL**

The technological revolution has changed life as we know it, forever. Your social media profiles represent: Christ, your testimony, your family, your workplace, and your church. It can be used as a powerful tool to minister to people, but it can also be used to tear down and divide others. Let’s be a people who are builders of people, using social media for positive activity. At the discretion of leadership, you may be asked to step down from the team should your social media profile activity cause any discord in the

church or is obviously inappropriate. Here are a few suggestions for proper social media etiquette:

- Treat everything you share like it is public. Digital communication is not private. It is so easy for anyone to take a screenshot of a conversation or photo and share it publicly.
- Sometimes face to face conversations are more appropriate. Email or instant messaging is not appropriate for sensitive matters, emotionally charged communication or if it requires extensive conversation. If a message is longer than a couple of sentences, it might be better to talk in person.
- Before every post or comment you make, ask yourself these questions: “why am I posting this?” / “Why am I ‘liking’ this?” / “Will this help someone else?” / “Would this cause anyone to stumble?” / “Would this embarrass someone?”

## [ GOD’S REQUIREMENTS ]

### LIFE OF INTEGRITY

At minimum all team members must be at least seeking what it means to follow Jesus Christ. *“Abstain from all appearance of evil.”* - I Thessalonians 5:22 / *“For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world.”* - I John 2:16 / *“Run from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, pursue righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the companionship of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts.”* - II Timothy 2:22

- Sexual immorality will not be tolerated:
  - If you are involved in a sexual relationship and are not married, we ask that you do not volunteer at this time.
  - Married couples must be committed to their spouse only; not to others, pornography, or anything outside the marriage relationship.
  - If you are pursuing a same-sex relationship, we ask that you not volunteer.
  - If you currently use or consume pornography (digital, print, film), we ask that you do not volunteer at this time.
- Abuse of drugs or of alcohol will not be tolerated.

### BE A CHEERFUL GIVER

*“Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”* - II Corinthians 9:7. Giving is the highest act of physical worship; the lead worshipers should lead the way. Where we spend our money shows where our priorities are. *“For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”* (Matthew 6:21).

## STUDY GOD'S WORD

*“All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness.”* - II Tim. 3:16. Jesus is the Living Word - to know Him more is to spend time in His word. Studying together in a small group is great for accountability and deeper intimacy with other believers.

## COMMUNITY

*“All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God’s grace was so powerfully at work in them all.”* - Acts 4:32-33. Being in community is life-giving because we find strength, unity, accountability, and fellowship. We strongly encourage each member of the team to be a part of a small group (of some kind). We want each person in our community to be known and to have healthy accountability. If you need help finding a group to connect with, please talk with our leadership.

# MUSICIANS, VOCALISTS, & PRODUCTION

## MUSICIANS

**Purpose:** To skillfully play instruments for the glory of God in a way that inspires the church to worship.

**Reports to:** Band Director

## PROCESS FOR JOINING THE TEAM AS A MUSICIAN:

- 1. Attend Growth Track, Step 1 and Step 2** - The Trinity Growth Track guides you to discover your purpose and live the life God created for you. Growth Track is made up of two steps that equip you to connect to the church, discover your strengths, develop your personal leadership, and to use your God-given gifts to make a difference in the lives of others. Step 1 happens every 1st Sunday at 11am, Step 2 happens every 2nd Sunday at 11am.
- 2. Read the TWC Worship Ministry Handbook**
- 3. Submit an Audition Video or sign up for Live Audition** - Videos can be submitted by visiting: [trinityworship.net/worshipauditions](http://trinityworship.net/worshipauditions), follow the instructions carefully and be sure to complete the form on this page. The audition process helps us to know where you are musically and to determine if you are a fit for the Worship Ministry. You will be contacted *only* if we have decided to move you forward in the audition process. Periodically, we will hold Live Auditions if there is a need and desire to do so.
- 4. Meet with the Director** - If we have decided to move you forward in the audition process, the director will connect with you to arrange a time to meet for the sake of communication. This meeting may also include further live auditioning.
- 5. Participate in Rehearsals** until the director determines it is time to begin serving. This is for the sake of gaining familiarity with team culture, the equipment, and for establishing some connections with other team members. We will also be observing your stage presence during this time.
- 6. Welcome to the Team!** Congratulations! It's time to start serving on rotation.

## CHARACTERISTICS OF AN EXCELLENT MUSICIAN

- Come prepared – knowing what songs are on the agenda, listen to each song carefully, listen to your vocal part mp3 file (if available), and read all details on each song for necessary information on Planning Center.
- Keep your general area clean.
- All players are responsible to keep up with their own music.
- Have your chord charts ready on a tablet or printed for rehearsals and celebrations. Clear the stage at least 15 minutes before each celebration; no playing or tuning on



stage during this time. This is so the mystery is not taken away from what is about to happen in the service. It can also be noisy and distracting to our guests.

- Follow the direction of the worship leader.
- Be flexible and prepare for spontaneity.
- Come into rehearsals knowing which tone(s) you will be using on any given song - this saves time during rehearsals.
- When playing in a band, don't always play your instrument at 100% capacity. Think as an arranger of the song. Layer the music so that not 2 instruments are playing exactly the same, unless called for. Think of what will benefit the song; playing less is usually more.
- Display genuine joy in your countenance. People need to see that you actually believe in the message of your song.

## VOCALISTS (Worship Leaders & Backing Vocalists)

**Purpose:** To connect the message of a song in a way that inspires the church to worship by using our voices for the glory of God.

**Reports to:** Worship Director and Vocal Director (Worship Leaders), Vocal Director (Backing Vocalists)

### PROCESS FOR JOINING THE TEAM AS A VOCALIST:

- 1. Attend Growth Track, Step 1 and Step 2** - The Trinity Growth Track guides you to discover your purpose and live the life God created for you. Growth Track is made up of two steps that equip you to connect to the church, discover your strengths, develop your personal leadership, and to use your God-given gifts to make a difference in the lives of others. Step 1 happens every 1st Sunday at 11am, Step 2 happens every 2nd Sunday at 11am.
- 2. Read the TWC Worship Ministry Handbook**
- 3. Submit an Audition Video** - All vocals begin as a background vocalist, so you must be able to hear and sing harmony independently. Videos can be submitted by visiting: [trinityworship.net/worshipauditions](http://trinityworship.net/worshipauditions), follow the instructions carefully and be sure to complete the form on this page. The audition process helps us to know where you are musically and to determine if you are a fit for the Worship Ministry. You will be contacted only if we have decided to move you forward in the audition process. Periodically, we will hold Live Auditions if there is a need and desire to do so.
- 4. Meet with the Director** - If we have decided to move you forward in the audition process, the director will connect with you to arrange a time to meet for the sake of communication. This meeting may also include further live auditioning.
- 5. Participate in Rehearsals** until the director determines it is time to begin serving. This is for the sake of gaining familiarity with team culture, the equipment, and for establishing some connections with other team members. We will also be observing your stage presence during this time.
- 6. Welcome to the Team!** Congratulations! It's time to start serving on rotation.

### CHARACTERISTICS OF AN EXCELLENT VOCALIST

- ALL vocalists should come prepared – knowing what songs are on the agenda, listen to each song carefully, listen to your vocal part mp3 file (if available), and read all details on each song on Planning Center.
- Display genuine joy in your countenance. People need to see that you actually believe in what you are singing.
- Please do not lead us into a place of worship that you have not been to personally. Our times of leading worship corporately should always be an overflow to our personal time of worship.

## BACKING VOCAL PARTS DEFINED

This is how we communicate the different vocal parts on Planning Center Online:

**HIGH:** The highest voice heard on the song. This could mean that the soprano is singing a backing melody, or it could mean that it is 1 part above the Lead, or it could mean it is 2 parts above the Lead.

**MIDDLE:** There can only be a middle part if there are at least 3 vocal parts to a song. This could mean an alto part (part just below soprano), or it could mean a backing melody that is between the high and low part, or it could mean the part that is between the Lead vocal and the highest harmony.

**LOW:** The lowest voice heard on the song. This could mean that the lowest part is a backing melody (because the other parts are above the lead), or it could mean a tenor part (2 harmonies down from a soprano lead), or it could mean 1 part beneath the Lead vocal.

## CHARACTERISTICS OF A WORSHIP LEADER

- Evidence of passion for worshiping God.
- Evidence of growing in discipleship.
- Faithful, available, and teachable.
- Leads with transparency so only Christ is visible.
- Skilled to lead the congregation into what worship is.
- Able to engage a crowd by words of encouragement and willingness to pray.
- Flexibility - serve / lead where needed most; both onstage and off stage.
- Supportive of the overall vision of Trinity Worship Center and the Worship Ministry.

# PRODUCTION TEAM: Producers, Sound, Lighting, & Media Techs

**Purpose:** To set the atmosphere by amplifying and enhancing the sound, provide appropriate lighting, and display excellent visuals on screens.

**Reports to:** Lead Producer (Lighting Techs, Media Techs, and Backstage Producers), Lead Sound Tech (Sound Techs).

## PROCESS FOR JOINING THE PRODUCTION TEAM:

- 1. Attend Growth Track, Step 1 and Step 2** - The Trinity Growth Track guides you to discover your purpose and live the life God created for you. Growth Track is made up of two steps that equip you to connect to the church, discover your strengths, develop your personal leadership, and to use your God-given gifts to make a difference in the lives of others. Step 1 happens every 1st and 3rd Sunday at 11am, Step 2 happens every 2nd and 4th Sunday at 11am.
  - 2. Read the TWC Worship Ministry Handbook**
  - 3. Meet with the Director** - If we have decided to move you forward in the process, the director will connect with you to arrange a time to meet for the sake of communication. This meeting may also include further live auditioning.
  - 4. Participate in Rehearsals** until the director determines it is time to begin serving. This is for the sake of gaining familiarity with team culture, the equipment, and for establishing some connections with other team members.
  - 5. Welcome to the Team!** Congratulations! It's time to start serving on rotation.
- You must be present for rehearsal in order to participate on Sunday so we can prepare together as a team.
  - Without sound, media, & lighting techs, nothing is seen or heard. We are at your mercy! It is crucial that you own the service as much as the worship leader and the pastor. You are driving the service, and production can either make or break an entire service.
  - Honor the Worship Leader in charge and the Pastor – The Worship Leader in charge and the Pastor have been entrusted with authority over the service. Please adhere to adjustments that are requested by either one of them.
  - Enthusiasm, please! – It's easy to walk in the middle of the road, be average, and just "wing it." Whenever someone dares to break rank and become enthusiastic about something, there'll always be someone who thinks they are being unrealistic or obsessive. But who cares? The truth is, people who are obsessed or unrealistic about an idea get more done than people who are without enthusiasm. Colossians 3:23 says, "Whatever you do, work at it with all of your heart, as working for the Lord,

not for man.” Your enthusiasm will minister to the worship team and to the entire church body.

- Excellence means “attention to detail.” There are many elements for each of you to pay attention to when you are “behind the wheel” driving a service. Many of those notes are clearly made for you on the weekly order of worship. There are logical reasons behind each note that have been thought through by the leadership in advance.
- Listen to the music before rehearsals to familiarize yourself with the arrangements.
- Producers are responsible for changing batteries before Production Service begins.
- Producers are responsible for setting the pastor’s speaking props.
- Eliminate as many distractions as possible - Some distractions include:
  - Sound too loud or too soft
  - Lighting too bright or Lighting too low (this can make people sleepy!)  
Sound feeding back
  - The speaker’s lapel is not working
  - Videos that don’t work (all videos should be tested before service. Pre-service music playing is abruptly stopped instead of faded
  - Blend of instruments and vocals is bad (lead vocal should be clearly heard for the congregation to have a chance to follow a melody).

These things detract from the flow of the service. It stops momentum and people take their eyes off Jesus. So it is our responsibility to prepare and combat any potential distractions in advance. Look, listen, and be aware.
